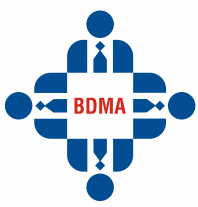

CSR ACTIVITIES BY

FIRMENICH AROMATICS PRODUCTION (INDIA) PVT LTD.DAHEJ

Firmenich has always believed in the inclusive and sustainable growth of its stakeholders and is confident that the initiatives undertaken will create opportunities and work toward a more equitable society.

Firmenich donated classroom furniture, including 50 desks and benches, to students at the Higher Secondary School in Dahej, allowing them to focus on learning in comfort thus improving their learning outcomes. The donation helped address the desk shortage and support the administration's focus on improving the educational environment in this region's schools.

Firmenich collaborated with the local administration on the eco-restoration of the water pond in the village of Dahej to improve the lives of the local community. The company's goal was to address the region's water scarcity, groundwater depletion, flooding, and stagnation. The restoration and development work concentrated on dewatering, distilling, and cleaning the pond while also landscaping the area around it. The pond's restoration also allowed it to recharge the area's groundwater table, resulting in a more sustainable ecosystem for future generations.

Responding swiftly to the global Covid-19 pandemic, Firmenich provided two oxygen plants with a capacity of 10m³/hr each, to the Community Health Centres at Netrang and Vagra. These oxygen plants were critical in assisting disadvantaged families and the elderly who visited healthcare facilities for medical treatment.

Sangaath, Facilitating Government Scheme

Coverage: It is a sustainable community development model being implemented in 17 villages for facilitating reach of Government schemes and services to the eligible beneficiaries thereby ensuring last mile reach of Govt. schemes intended as various beneficiaries and demonstrating improvement in the village development index. A total of 13071 applicants received benefit for different prerequisite documents and schemes during the quarter.

Project Neem Sattva: A group of small and marginal women took a major leap into entrepreneurship by showing their interest for this project and formed an SHG group. In 2020 Deepak Foundation had conceptualized an innovative project to create livelihood opportunities for 100 rural women in Bharuch district by producing and marketing of neem-based hygiene products like sanitizers, handwashes, and hand curated soaps. These women are earning an average monthly income of nearly INR 2500 by working in afternoon hours after completion of household chore. These women generated INR 4.78 Lacs sales revenue in 18 months.

Mobile Health Unit: The project was initiated considering that the cost of seeking health care services are exorbitantly high in private sector, and Govt. facilities were not able to provide good quality care. The communities expressed need for good quality health services. The Mobile Health Unit provides doorstep services in 34 villages in Bharuch. The Foundation provide services to around 15000 patients through OPD services, providing around 8000 people with counselling and health education services and creating awareness among 60% population on basic preventive health care practices.

Deepak Laboratory and Diagnostic Centre in Dahej: In entire Dahej area, state of the art diagnostic facility was found to be lacking. Hence the initiative for a high quality and comprehensive diagnostic facility was started. The laboratory provides affordable, accessible, and reliable diagnostic services in Dahej PCPIR region to general population and employees of various industries to ensure their safety, well-being, and early diagnosis of any complications/ diseases.

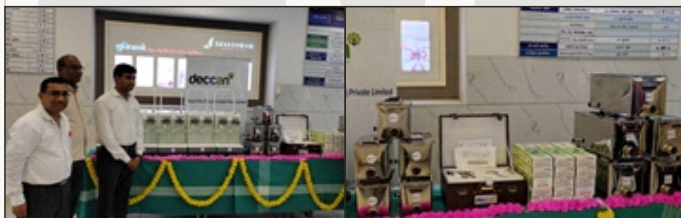

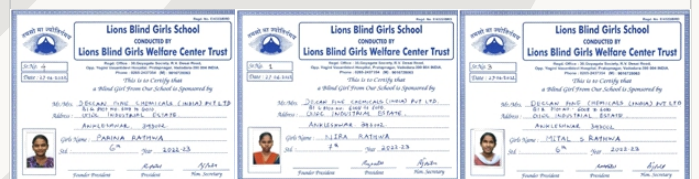
