#### **'BUILDING RESILIENCE TO BOUNCE BACK FROM COVID 19'**



The biggest drivers of resiliency are emotion regulation, self-compassion and cognitive agility. Research says highly resilient individuals are far better in times of distress.

Adopt an agile mind-set: Mental agility starts with openness and curiosity. When you are curious, you ask Why? And How? These answers can help you begin to see things from different perspectives and come up with solutions. Make Space for your emotions: when you face a setback it is okay to let yourself feel a range of emotions. Emotions are neither good or bad, they just are. Reframe the Situation: when you face an adverse situation ask yourself: Is there a better way to look at this? Take care of yourself: It can be hard to bounce back when you are anxious, tired, or feeling rundown. Take a break, get adequate sleep, exercise and keep healthy diet. Maintain social connections. Make a conscious effort to connects with others each day.


